*The Diversity Committee of the APA Division 49 Society of Group Psychology and Group Psychotherapy is soliciting proposals for **student posters** with themes central to the promotion of cultural diversity and equity in groups for a special student poster session at the 2020 APA Convention in Washington, DC.*

- Posters may present research, practical/clinical work, or advocacy efforts aimed at promoting cultural diversity in groups – broadly defined as small groups that may or may not be therapeutic (e.g., work/task groups, counseling groups, sports teams).
 - The (first) author of the posters should be a student. Note that APAGS members may receive reduced or free registration for the annual APA convention if they are listed as the first authors of APA presentations.
 - Authors should indicate that the poster is to be considered for the Cultural Diversity in Groups Student Poster Session.
 - The deadline for proposal submissions is 5:00 p.m. ET on Monday, December 2, 2019. Poster proposals submitted will be reviewed following the standard procedures for poster submissions.
