

Hello Division 6 Colleagues,

I would like to encourage you to recognize the significant scientific contributions of your Division 6 colleagues by nominating them for election to Fellow status next year. Please consider nominating others, as well as yourself.

The criteria for nomination are:

1. At least five years of experience in Behavioral Neuroscience or Comparative Psychology since earning the doctorate
2. Publication of significant contributions in the field of Behavioral Neuroscience or Comparative Psychology in addition to research carried out for the doctoral degree
3. Actively engaged in research, broadly defined
4. Professional achievements that are unusual and outstanding, with demonstrated national impact
5. APA member for at least one year

Please consider contacting anyone you are considering nominating, because there is a time commitment involved in the application process. The first step in the process is to email me (hhill1@stmarytx.edu or by return email) with the name and contact information for the nominee. If the nominee meets the basic eligibility criteria, I will contact them to determine their interest in pursuing Fellow status. Interested applicants will complete an on-line form and must solicit nominating letters from three current APA Fellows. Nominees who are already a Fellow in another division need only provide a curriculum vita that demonstrates evidence of activities related to the mission of Division 6. Nominations approved by the Division 6 Fellows Committee will be advanced to the APA Fellows Committee in February 2019. Successful nominees will be officially elected to Fellows status during the APA Convention in August 2020.
